The fee reduction is publicized and open to all; and 4. The fee reduction is limited in duration.

The Parks and Recreation Director is authorized to set fees for Recreation activities, programs and services, subject to the following standards: 1. Recreational programs and services shall benefit both the participant and the community due to their educational, cultural, and physical value. 2. Recreational programs and services require facilities, supplies, equipment, and/or considerable staff planning and supervision specific to the program and therefore, it is appropriate to charge a fee for these programs and services. Some examples include, but are not limited to instructional programs, summer day camp, senior programs, teen programs, special events, and youth/adult athletic programs. 3. Fees will not exceed the reasonable cost to the City of providing the program, class, or service. 4. Fees will remain affordable to allow access to community members, especially youth and seniors; and 5. Contractually taught class fees will be set based on availability of instructor, instructor costs, as these programs follow city purchasing policy.
